



ÉVORA | PORTUGAL

Évora is a mid-sized city in Portugal and main urban center of the Alentejo, the country's largest region. It is located on the Iberian plain, characterized by a gentle landscape and mild climate throughout the year. Situated about 120 km from Lisbon, with excellent access to the major international airport and 100 km from both the Spanish border and the industrial area of Porto de Sines, on the Atlantic coast.

With over 2000 years of history, Évora has been recognized by UNESCO as World Heritage in 1986. With a population of about 56.000 is a modern vibrant city, a renowned cultural and touristic hub in Portugal with great quality of life.

Aeronautic Industrial Park (PIAE)

The park, with a total area of 865.416 m², has 15 plots of land for the use of aeronautic industry.

Currently in Évora, there are four major industries: two of EMBRAER PORTUGAL, one of Structures in Composites and the other of Metallic Structures; Air Olesa Systems for Aeronautical Components and Mecachrome Aeronautics enterprise.

The industrial plots are sold in full ownership and have the following infrastructure: water supply, sewage network, solid waste collection, telecommunications network (optical fibre), electricity, natural gas, firefighting network.

The PIAE is located about 6 km from the city centre, 1.5 km from the Municipal Aerodrome and 2 km from the Industrial and Technological Park of Évora. It also has easy access to the A6 motorway (Lisbon-Madrid).

Specific Professional Training courses for the aeronautic sector

One can find in Évora, free of charge training courses specifically targeted for the aeronautic sector: Aeronautic Production – Assembly of structures; Metal treatment; Machination CNC (Computerized Numerical Control) and Production and Processing of Composites.

Évora Municipal Aerodrome

Considered one of the best aerodromes of Portugal, it has certified Rescue Service and a Fire Combat Class III for aircrafts of class II and for those of the Civil Protection. For the remaining aircrafts, it has available a permanent brigade service as well as AFIS (flight information service of the aerodrome).

It has capacity to accommodate companies and organizations of various activities related to aeronautics, such as leisure and sport activities, among others.
